St. Agnes, the Patron Saint of our St. Agnes Parish was killed for her faith at the young age of 12. She is the patroness of young girls, and other patronages. She is often pictured holding the martyr's palm branch, and with a lamb. St. Agnes is depicted in art with a lamb, as her name resembles the Latin word for "lamb", agnus. Her name "Agnes" is derived from the feminine Greek adjective "hagnē" meaning "Chaste, pure, sacred".
