On Pentecost Sunday, May 31, Pope Francis released his message for this year's celebration. Based on theme taken from the Book of

Isaiah, "*Here am I, send me*", the Pope's message says that the Covid-19 pandemic is an opportunity for mission and service to others.

World Mission Day, or Mission Sunday, was instituted by Pope Pius XI in 1926, to remind Catholics about their commitment and support to the missionary work of the Church through prayer and sacrifice.
