Petition Number 17

Mother Mary, we pray for the Church, especially for the Pope, Bishops, Priests, Deacons, and all Religious and Missionaries who have consecrated their lives to serve God and Mankind. May they always be renewed in Spirit. Please strengthen their faith to help them to be faithful in serving their ministries. Protect them from sickness, harm and evil, so that they may serve in love with more diligence. We also pray for all persecuted people of the earth. Please help and protect them. Mother Mary, we pray for all souls to be consecrated to your Immaculate Heart.

Please give them strength, courage, and the understanding to endure their trials and offer their suffering to your Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ. May they be strong in faith, in hope and in love. Mother Mary, we also pray for the dying. May your grace be with them in their last hour, to give them hope for the salvation of their souls. We pray especially for those who suffer an untimely death. May they receive the blessing and mercy of your Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ. Mother Mary, we also ask for your love and mercy for the elderly, the infirm, the bedridden, and the handicapped. Please give them courage and protection. May your grace become their strength and sustenance.

We thank you Mother Mary, and your Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ for the many blessings granted to us.

The Memorare

Remember, O most compassionate Virgin Mary, that never was it known that anyone who fled to your protection, implored your assistance, or sought your intercession, was left unaided. Inspired with this confidence, we fly unto you, O Virgin of Virgins our Mother; to you we come; before you we kneel, sinful and sorrowful. O Mother of the Word Incarnate, despise not our petitions, but in your clemency, hear and answer them Amen.

You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened-up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelope the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us. O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a font of mercy for us. Jesus, I trust in You! (3 times)

Pray the Our Father, Hail Mary, and Apostles' Creed.

On each Our Father beads

Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

On each Hail Mary bead

For the sake of his sorrowful passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

In conclusion, say three times:

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

Closing Prayer
