Sacramental Preparation for Children:

You are your child's primary teacher of faith, morals, and values. Sacraments are signs of God's love for those who receive them. Grace, God's unconditional love, comes to us in a special way through sacraments.

If your child has not been baptized, we encourage you to contact our office and we will be glad to talk to you about it.

When your child enters grade 2, they begin preparation for two sacraments, Reconciliation and Eucharist. In the Catholic school system, your child will be guided through a religion program that helps with that preparation. The Sacramental Prep team will guide you through some important meetings and enrollment here at St. Agnes.

When your child enters Grade 7, they begin preparation for the sacrament of Confirmation. Throughout the year, you and your child will take part in a program led by our Pastor and Sacramental Preparation Team in conjunction with your child's teacher. Confirmation is celebrated in May or June.

If you have a child at St. Mary's High School, invite them to say hello to Deacon Ed MacIntosh who serves as Chaplain at the school.
