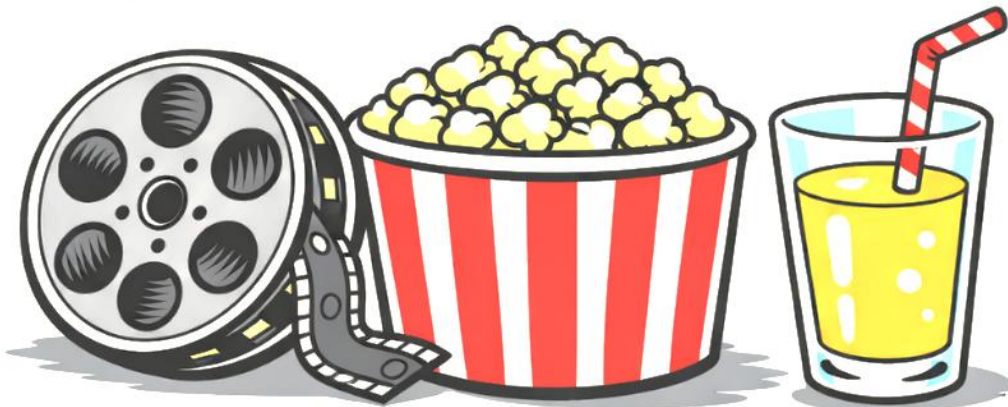
Update your address, phone & email.

There are so many things in the Catholic Church to experience, know and understand, that we can spend our whole lives in the Church and never see it all. If you’ve grown up in and around the Church, these things may be habit, and we may not really understand where they came from or why they are there. If you are new in the Church, you have a unique perspective, and your questions lead us all to deeper thinking.

During this series, we will use many references that guide our thinking, especially:



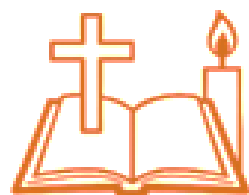
Canon Law: The official, comprehensive system of ecclesiastical laws governing the Church – including the rights of the faithful, administration, the sacraments, and disciplinary norms. It translates theology into daily governance, ensuring fairness, order, and the protection of rights.



The GIRM: The General Instruction of the Roman Missal - the universal rulebook for how the Mass is celebrated. It preserves unity and consistency in worship across the world.



The CCCB: The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops – the national assembly of bishops in Canada. It applies universal Church law to Canada’s pastoral and cultural context (e.g., national feasts, liturgical adaptations).



The CCC: The Catechism of the Catholic Church – a comprehensive reference summarizing doctrine, morals, sacraments, and prayer. It serves as a “sure norm” for teaching the faith, making doctrine clear and accessible.
